COVID-19 Code of Conduct: Exposure

If you have been in close contact with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in the last 10 days:

- 1. Begin wearing a high-quality mask around others.
- 2. After exposure, get tested on day 6; at least 5 full days after your last exposure.
- 3. If the test result is negative, continue to wear a mask until day 10, when around other people.
- 4. Watch for symptoms. If symptoms develop, test again.
- 5. If the test result is positive, follow the COVID-19 Code of Conduct Policy for a positive test.
